

SRA Transparency Rules **Probate – Grant Only**

Note: The pricing below provides an example of our costs for this service area. We have always operated an open and transparent process. How much does this service cost?

TOTAL: fixed fee of £780.00 (incl. VAT).

This includes: Obtaining the grant only. All other aspects of the estate are to be handled by you.

Breakdown of costs:

Legal fees £650.00

VAT on legal fees £130.00

Disbursements (from £162.00 in total):

- Probate court fee of £155.00.
- £7.00 Swearing of the oath (per executor).

Disbursements are costs related to your matter that are payable to third parties, such as court fees.

We handle the payment of the disbursements on your behalf to ensure a smoother process.

As part of our fixed fee we will:

- Provide you with a dedicated and experienced probate specialist to work on your matter
- Identify the legally appointed executors or administrators and beneficiaries
- Accurately identify the type of Probate application you will require
- Obtain the relevant documents required to make the application
- Complete the Probate Application and the relevant HMRC forms

- Make the application to the Probate Court on your behalf
- Obtain the Probate and securely send to you. If any additional copies of the grant are required, they will cost £0.50 each.

This quote is for estates where:

- There is no claim for the transfer of any unused nil rate band allowance of the deceased's late spouse
- There is no inheritance tax payable and the executors do not need to submit a full account to HMRC

Typically, obtaining the grant of probate takes 8-12 weeks.
